



## COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

**Please note, we hope that these measures are somewhat temporary, but we have no timeline on COVID-19 and they will be enforced for as long as we need to protect everyone to the best of our ability.**

- 1) All students, exhibitors or anyone on premise must sign a waiver of prior to entering the training facility.
- 2) All students, exhibitors or visitors must have their temperature taken with a non-contact thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will be asked to leave the premises.
- 3) Only handlers can be in the building (no spectators, spouses, significant others etc at this time).
- 4) During group discussions and walkthroughs we ask students to maintain an adequate "social distance".
- 5) Crating for now will be out of cars
- 6) High Octane crates will not be available for use.
- 7) Masks must be worn at all times while on the premises except (a) When instructing from a social distance and (b) While running your dog.
- 8) We will be utilizing an entry and an exit door. The entry door will be the "normal" door closest to the barn aisle, while the exit door will be on the door on the far side of the arena. These doors will be left open during class time.
- 9) We will provide hand sanitizer inside the entry door for your use if you wish.
- 10) We appreciate help with setting equipment and have hand sanitizer and gloves available. We request using the hand sanitizer before and after touching any equipment. We understand if you are not comfortable helping at this time, we want everyone to feel safe while training.
- 11) You may use the "normal property boundaries" to exercise your dog between turns, but you must wear a mask and maintain social distancing guidelines.
- 12) While we understand classes are generally a social atmosphere, we ask that you keep appropriate (ideally 6 foot distance) from each other.
- 13) If you attend any large social or other event or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive or is not feeling well, please do not come to High Octane for fourteen days following these events. Social events include large agility Regionals, Nationals, Beaches, and Parties of more than 20 people. We need to do what we can to protect our students, instructors and ourselves as best as possible and we ask that you help us do so.
- 14) Please sanitize your hands often while you are on premise.
- 15) **DO NOT COME TO CLASS IF YOU ARE ILL!!!**
- 16) If you do test positive or suspect exposure to COVID-19, please tell us immediately so we can take action.
- 17) Failure to adhere to High Octane's COVID-19 Policies and Procedures may result in removal from classes and revocation of training privileges without refund.
